What a fabulous morning we had this week—lovely to see lots of you attending and the children enjoying themselves with a bit of competition!

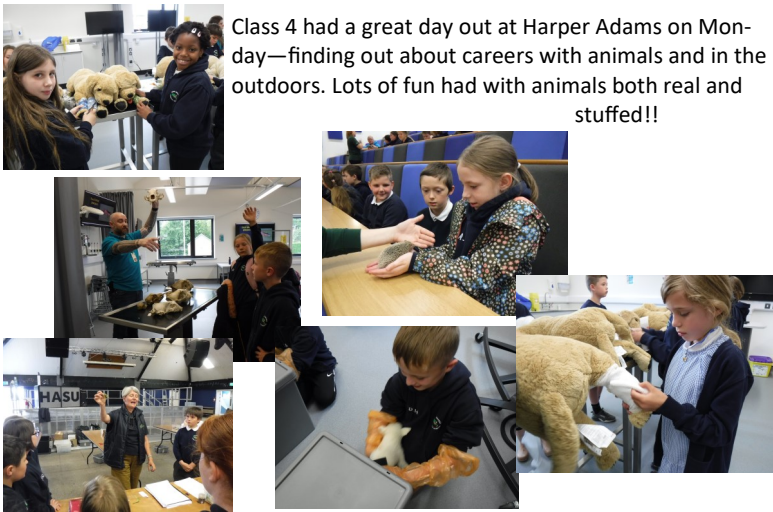
The results were very close: Wrekin Blue 215, Ercall Red 218, Houghmond Yellow, winners with 220.
