Spelling Focus Words

As part of our drive to support children with key spellings, you might notice that your child has a word written in a bubble in their homework book, or reading diary in key stage 1. We are trying to support the children to spell key words correctly, and research shows that writing a word in lots of ways—with colours, in different pens - and lots of times, helps to correct words which have become 'fixed' incorrectly.

Please could you help your child to 'fix' the correct spelling by practising that one word several times each night. By practising at school too, we hope to increase the spelling accuracy of our children.
