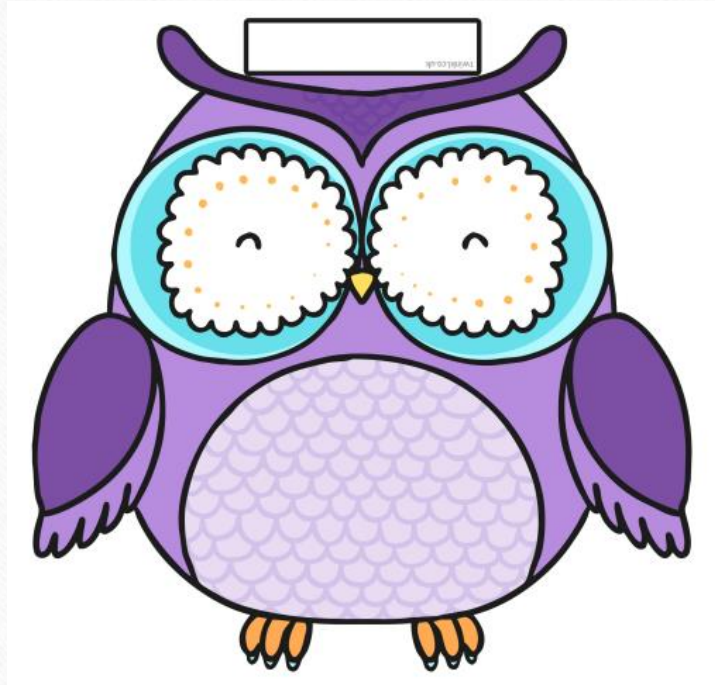


Welcome to Class 3

Daily guided reading sessions will focus on reading comprehension and the language features of fiction, non-fiction texts and poetry.

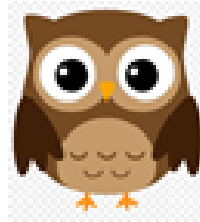
Our class reader for the first half term is 'Matilda' by Roald Dahl. For the second half term we will be reading 'The Great Chocoplut' by Chris Callaghan.
