English

We will be focusing on writing to inform this half term and writing to persuade next half term. Daily guided reading sessions will focus on reading comprehension using the following class books:

Mathematics

This term we will be focusing on place value. This will include knowing the value of each digit up to a 7 digit number and developing a written method of calculation for the 4 operations as well as some fraction work and converting of units.

Science

In the first half of the term Y6 will be focusing on living things and their habitats and then electricity in the second half. Y5 will begin with forces and then go onto space.

In C5 we will be using instruments and our voices to perform 'You've Got a Friend' by Carole King and appraise songs from the same genre. There will also be seasonal performances.

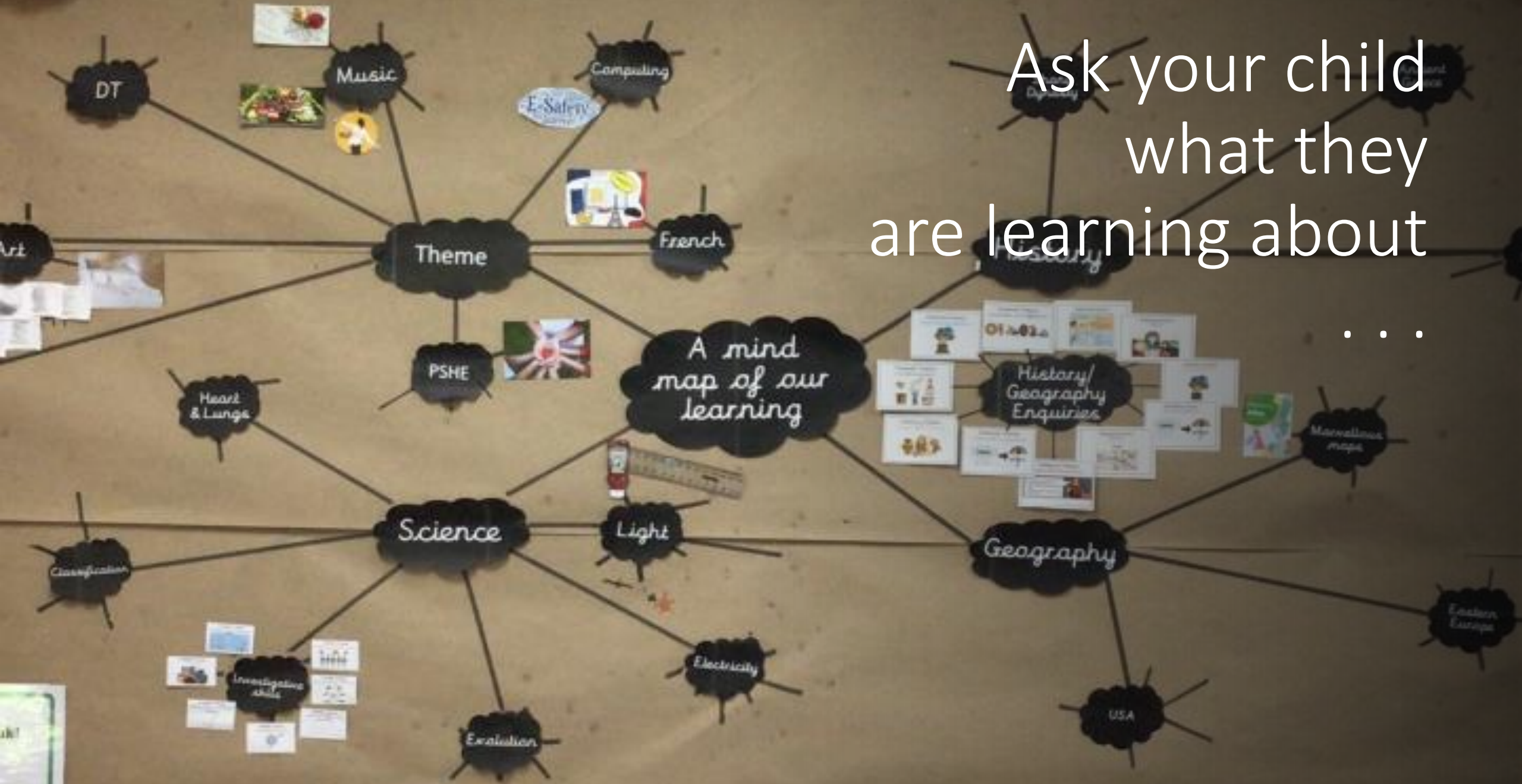
Computing
