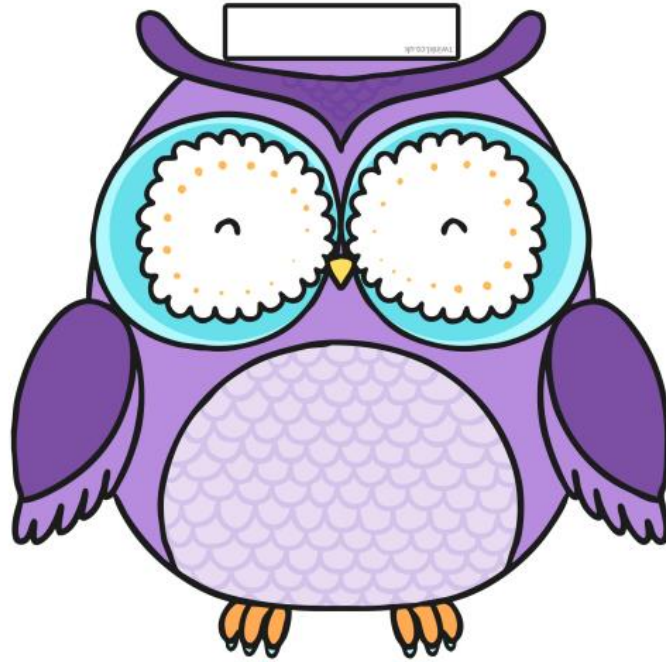


Welcome to Class 3



Key information

English

Science

Across the term, year 3 will learn about skeletons, movement, nutrition and diet, food waste, rocks, fossils, soils and light.

Year 4 will learn about grouping and classifying, data collection, states of matter, sound, electricity.

Art & DT
