English

We will focus on applying phanics to write words and structure sentences. We will also learn about noun phrases and how to use noun phrases and how to use these to add detail to our wark.

Mathematics

Throughout this term we will focus on counting, reading and writing numbers, number order and place value. We will also cover addition, subtraction and shape.

Science

We will be investigating materials and their properties. At home you could talk about what different items are made from and why. Yrl will also learn about the human body and seasons, while Yr2 learn more about things animals need to survive.

PSHE

We will be exploring digital wellbeing, which links to our computing about staying safe online.

Computing

The children will learn about internet safety and creating simple digital music.

ART & DT

In Art we will explore monoprint and DT will be textiles where the children learn to join fabrics with simple stitches.

RE
