Reception children will be drawing and making marks in Drawing Club. They will be sharing, acting out and retelling lots of familiar stories. Year I children will be developing their writing through Drawing Club by forming letters more carefully and using what they have learnt in phonics to write simple sentences. All children will have a daily phonics lesson which will include reading, writing and a guided reading session linked to what they have learnt.

Mathematics.

Reception children will be singing lots of count ing songs, playing number games, counting amounts and concentrating on counting, ordering and manipulating numbers to 5.

Year I children will be consolidating their understanding of place value to 10, then moving onto numbers to 20, adding and subtracting and naming 2D and 3D shapes.

We will be learning about a range of everyday materials and their properties. The children will have apportunities to find out about why certain materials are used for different purposes. The children will learn more about the human body and their senses. They will also have lots of appartunities to investigate the natural world and seasonal change through play and forest school

We will be studying our local area and thinking about the farms we see around our school. The children will use stories and a local walk to find out more about what a warking farm is like and use local maps to place them in the locality and in relation to the school.

Geography

Class 1

Reception and Year I

History

We will be learning about the Great Fire of London. The children will be using some real artefacts, books and pictures to bring the events to life.

RE and PSHE

We try to be responsive and talk about feelings, emotions and warries that affect the children in Class 1. The children will be talking about what makes them unique and recognising their own positive qualities. We will also learn about the nativity story.

Computing

The children will learn about internet safety and use simple programs.

PE is on Tuesday doing dance and gymnastics. Forest school is on a Friday.

Art and DT

In our focussed DT lessons we will be learning about fruit and vegetable and preparing a healthy salad. We will be learning to chap and use knives carefully. In Art we will be looking at printing.

Music

In Music we will be listening to different types of music, singing action songs and performing a simple piece together.

Helping at home

You can support your child by reading with them at least 5 times a week; helping them identify the sounds they have been learning in phonics and playing games which help them count, order and recognise numbers.
