Welcome back!

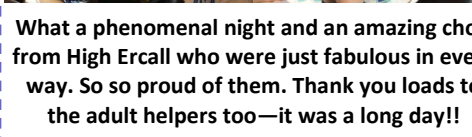

Please bring along any tools you have too—wheelbarrows, plus rakes / shovels would be good!

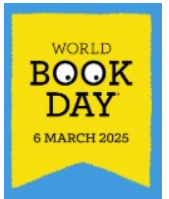
